About

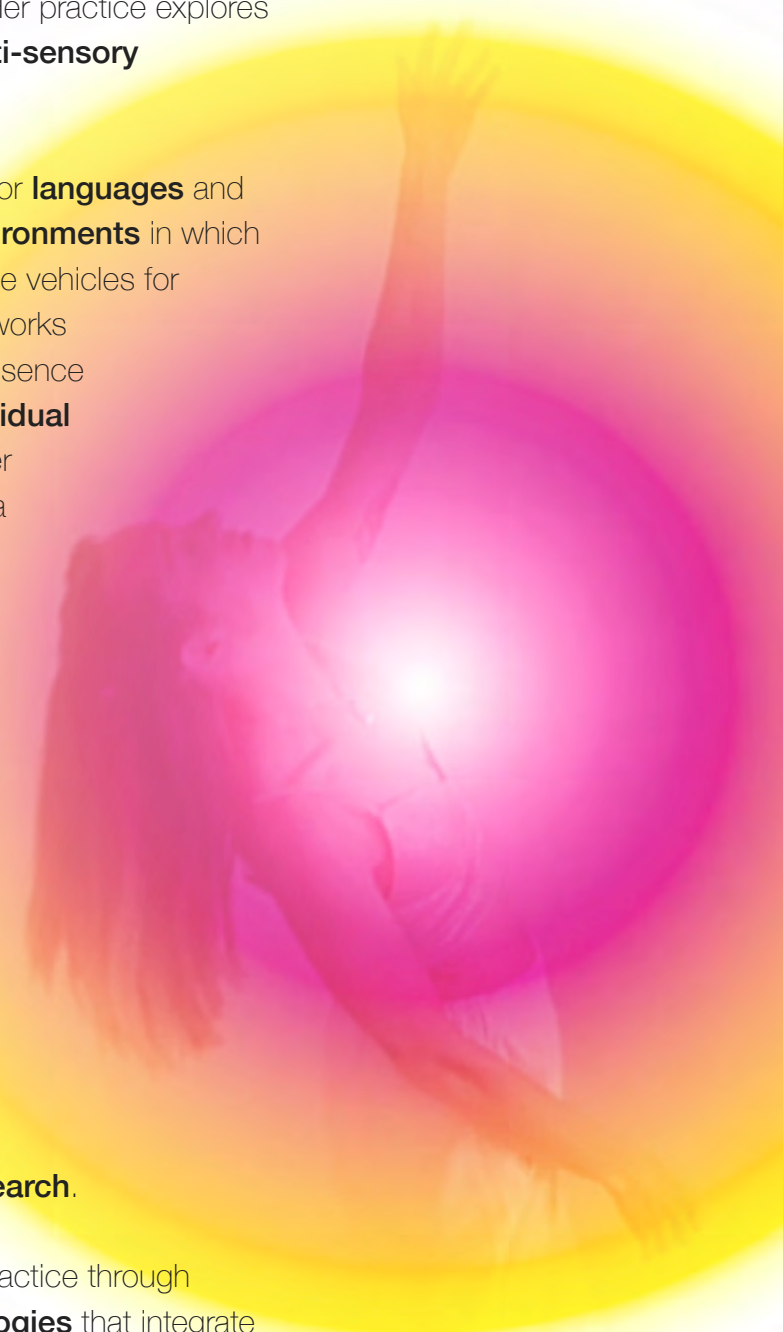
Katja-Anina Brosius is a **multidisciplinary artist**, contemporary mystic and meditation teacher working across **spatial sound, voice, installation, performance** and **visual media**. Her practice explores expanded states of consciousness through **multi-sensory experiences** for **body, mind** and **spirit**.

Within a realm of deep knowledge and passion for **languages** and new age **prayers**, Brosius develops **poetic environments** in which sound, space, meditation, light and color become vehicles for **contemplation** and **transformation**. Thus her works invite into moments of **inner awareness** and presence while **exploring the relationship** between **individual consciousness** and **collective experience**. Her works reflect a deep devotion to the path of yoga and the universal threads that unite cultures, beliefs, and spiritual traditions.

Brosius holds a Master's degree with distinction in **Media Arts** from **Karlsruhe University of Arts and Design**, where she was member of the **research group KIM** (*Künstliche Intelligenz und Medienphilosophie*) for **Artificial Intelligence** and **Media Philosophy**.

Her artistic projects and research have been **presented internationally** through exhibitions, installations, performances, and interdisciplinary collaborations, receiving **numerous grants** and **awards** recognizing her **innovative artistic research**.

Since the early 2020s, she has expanded her practice through the **development of contemplative methodologies** that integrate the experience of multimedia art, meditation, and heart-centered awareness, **positioning art** as a **catalyst for reflection, inter-cultural participation, contemplation** and universal **connection**.



Love Letters From Garden Eden

MULTI-SENSORY SONIC ART CONCERT

2026 - ongoing

Love Letters from Garden Eden is a **participatory sonic art experience** that merges **contemporary performance, immersive listening, cacao meditation, and contemplative practice**. The work transforms the concert format into an intimate, multi-sensory journey, inviting audiences to sit comfortably or recline within a carefully composed environment of sound, voice, and presence.

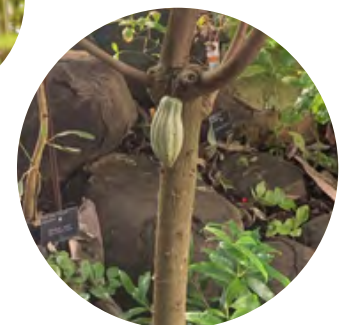
Through live **singing, spoken word, spiritual invocations, guided meditation, sounds of nature, and original electro-acoustic compositions**, Brosius creates poetic soundscapes where natural environments intertwine with **guitar, bells, and subtle electronic textures**. Selected paintings and **luminous visual works** further shape the atmosphere, extending the experience into a contemplative visual space that evokes **expanded states of awareness and imagination**.

A central element of the work is a **guided cacao meditation**, in which each participant receives a piece of ceremonial chocolate. The **act of tasting** becomes **part of the artistic composition** itself—a meditation on attention, embodiment, and sensory perception.

Creating a space for introspection, heart-centered connection, and **collective reflection**, Love Letters from Garden Eden can be presented in **stereo** or **3D ambisonics**, adapting to the acoustic possibilities of each venue.

MULTI MEDIA VISUAL & SONIC PAINTINGS

2012 - ongoing

Starseeds is an evolving series of **immersive energy artworks**. Bridging contemporary fine art with **light frequency, color psychology, and intuitive symbolism**, the collection invites an **experience that is felt**. Drawing inspiration from **contemplative and mystical practices**, deep meditations, energywork and neuroaesthetics, each **work functions as a visual field of resonance for body, mind and spirit**.

Through carefully orchestrated relationships of colour, form, and luminosity, the **paintings encourage stillness, reflection, nervous system regulation, and subtle energetic coherence**. Many collectors, exhibition visitors, and wellness professionals describe the works as calming, uplifting, and deeply centering. Rooted in the experience that **meditation enhances presence, clarity, emotional balance**, and overall wellbeing, the **Starseed Collection extends beyond the visual realm into a holistic, multi-sensory experience**. Selected artworks are accompanied by **original spatial-audio poetry**, binaural and ambisonic **soundtracks**, and **guided meditations** composed specifically for each piece. These sonic elements deepen the contemplative encounter, supporting relaxation, mindfulness, and emotional resonance.

Together, image, sound, and meditative atmosphere transform the artworks into immersive consciousness environments—**spaces that invite restoration, reflection, and expanded perception**.

AMBISONIC FILM & LIVE PERFORMANCE

Born from a series of profound meditative visions, this art film follows two protagonists on a surreal journey across a world where water has disappeared. In **search of Gaia's last pure spring**, they travel through landscapes suspended between dream, memory, and possible future. Conceived during the artist's studies at the Karlsruhe University of Arts and Design and developed independently since 2020, the film **explores emotional reconnection, inner truth, and humanity's relationship with nature.**



The Flower Of The Heart

ART & CONSCIOUSNESS WORKSHOP

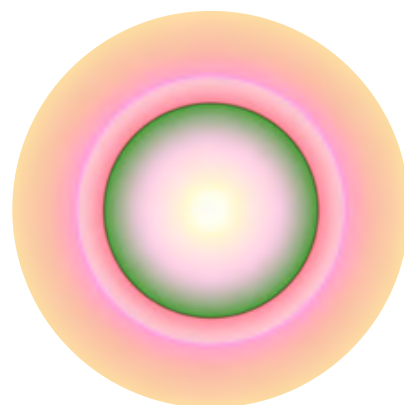

The Flower of the Heart is an **interdisciplinary workshop** exploring the **relationship between meditation, creativity, and conscious artistic practice**.

Through guided inner journeys, **mindfulness exercises**, and **contemplative techniques**, participants are invited to **connect with their intuitive and emotional intelligence** before engaging in **creative expression**. Writing, drawing, and painting become tools for listening, sensing, and creating from a deeper inner source.

The workshop offers a space where **art** is approached as a **process of awareness** and self-discovery, encouraging participants to cultivate **presence, authenticity, and trust in their own creative voice**. Situated at the intersection of art, spirituality, and personal transformation, Flower of the Heart explores how inner perception can become a foundation for meaningful artistic creation.

The title is inspired in part by the writings of **Thérèse of Lisieux**, who **envisioned humanity as a garden of many different flowers**, each expressing a **unique form of beauty and purpose**. Drawing on this metaphor, the workshop celebrates intercultural exchange, and the **richness of individual perspectives and creativity**. Just as a garden flourishes through the presence of many distinct blossoms, communities are enriched **through the diversity of our talents and qualities**.

Landalove, Landalive

AMBISONIC & IMMERSIVE ANIMATION FILM

2022

Landalove, Landalive is an **immersive ambisonic animation film** that evolved from an **experimental radio play**. Written in **poetic form**, the work follows a once highly developed ship's crew from a distant galaxy after their vessel sinks into the 'Seas of Lost Hearts'. Their journey through oceans, enchanted forests, intelligent networks, and celestial landscapes becomes a search for memory, identity, and belonging. Three-dimensionally spatialized soundscapes weave together **poetry, vocals**, the sounds of water, desert, wind, and the cosmos, alongside **electroacoustic composition**, and synthetic voices. **Sound becomes both architecture and storyteller**, immersing the audience in a contemplative journey across inner and outer worlds. At the heart of the story is **Sir Neuron 1068**, an artificial neuron voiced by the artist, reminding audiences of essential challenges that are to be faced through the evolution of technology.

Inspired by the symbolic presence of the wheel of karma in contrast to ascended states of beingness, the **film explores consciousness, spiritual evolution, and humanity's relationship with artificial intelligence**.

Developed between 2020 and 2023 through **interdisciplinary collaborations** spanning art, **AI research, acoustic mathematics**, and **spatial audio**, the work invites audiences into a poetic journey on **memory, consciousness**, and the **evolving dialogue between human and machine**.

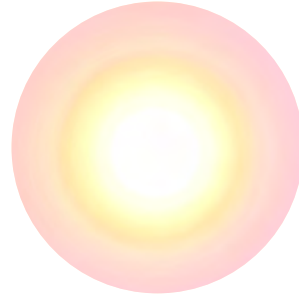

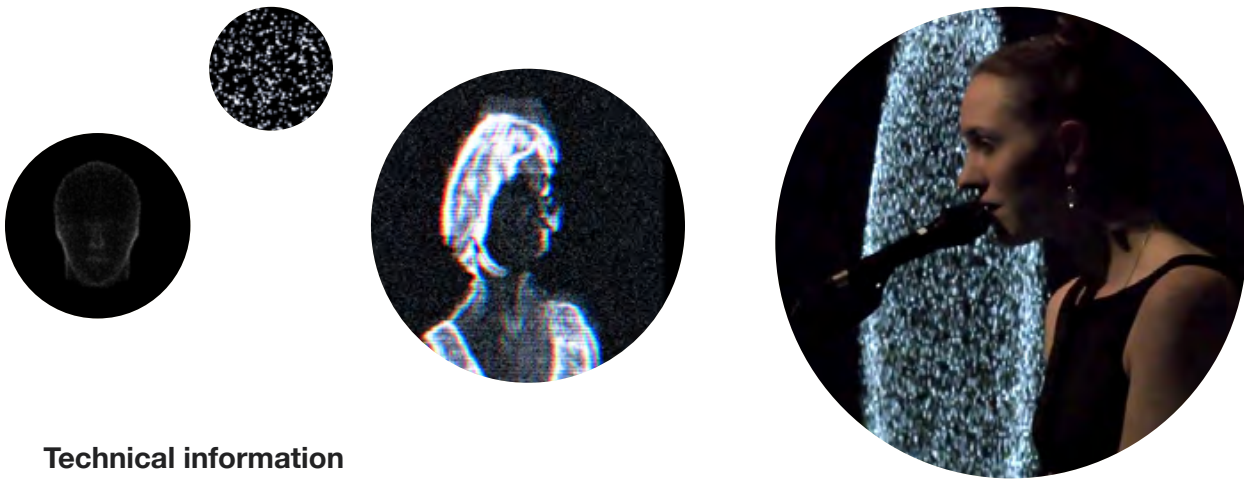

The **immersive spatial sonic live performance** *Mit dem Mond im Gesicht* (*With The Moon In Her Face*) tells the story of a **soul travel** through cosmic spheres. The longing for a moment of **unity** is continuously being confronted with **lostness** and **chaos** before a return home can take place.

The composition is a **poetic** and **experimental sound-collage** of **sonic texture-waving** including choir, piano, vocals, sound-design, percussion, modular synth and field recordings.

Opensourcepraying (Kumpane No. 44) is an **interactive sound sculpture** exploring **machine consciousness, prayer, and dialogue beyond the human**. Inspired by the philosophies of Vilém Flusser and Martin Buber, as well as research within the AI group KIM, the work asks: **What is the consciousness of a machine?** How might a machine perceive humanity, and could technological systems one day embody values beyond those of their creators? If technological systems reflect human values stronger and deeper the further the evolution grows, which **virtues are we cultivating within them today**, and which **forms of influence** are shaping the future of **machine consciousness?**

Constructed from glass, the sculpture recites its own **prayer** in **Hebrew, German, English, Spanish, and Russian**. Through an **ultrasonic sensor**, a paradoxical encounter unfolds: as visitors approach, the prayer grows louder; as they withdraw, it fades into silence.

Between **proximity** and **distance, observer** and **observed**, Opensourcepraying creates a space for **reflection on consciousness**, technology, and the **possibility of new forms of awareness**. Rather than offering answers, the work invites audiences into a poetic dialogue with the unknown.

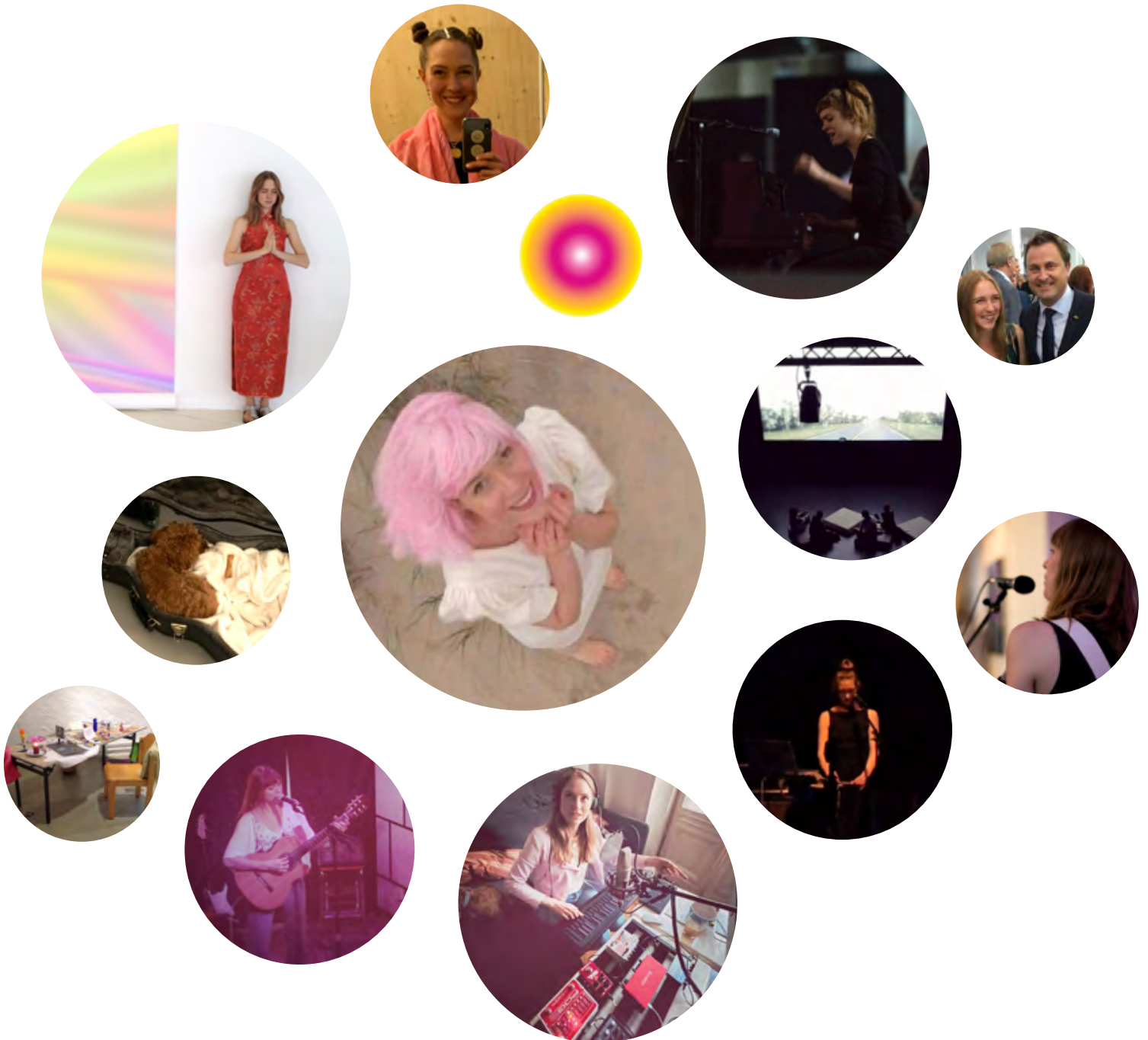
